

## **PUBLIC NOTICE: RECRUITMENT FOR THE CITY OF LIVINGSTON CONSERVATION BOARD**

The City of Livingston Conservation Committee is looking to fill five (5) city-citizen positions and one (1) youth seat on the newly created City Conservation Board. The purpose of this board is to identify opportunities for the City of Livingston to reduce costs and promote sustainable growth by implementing energy-efficient equipment, procedures, or systems, and incorporate renewable energy when feasible. The Board shall act in an advisory capacity to the City Commission on topics such as building efficiency strategies, renewable energy, recycling, tracking of energy use, and energy-saving initiatives.

To be eligible for consideration you must be a U.S. citizen who is at least 18 years of age or (15-19 for the youth seat), a qualified elector, a resident of Park County, the State of Montana and the City of Livingston for at least 30 days, a non-felon of sound mind and willing to submit to a protective services background check. Members will serve two (2) year terms based on the calendar year with the youth member serving a one (1) year term based on the school year (July-June).
