Now Hiring Lifeguards and Swim Instructors for the 2017 Pool Season

The City of Livingston is currently recruiting for this season's Lifeguards and Swim Instructors! Must enjoy the outdoors, working with citizens of all ages and being part of a team that enjoys camaraderie, having fun at work and providing a safe environment for our community pool.

Certification Classes will be offered May 22 – 26 (5:30-9pm) and All Day May 28/29 in Livingston. You **MUST** be available to attend training to be considered for a position.

Qualifications:

- To comply with Child Labor Laws, staff must be at least 15 years of age;
- Must possess the following certifications, or be able to become certified in the classes provided by the City at no expense!
 - ☆ Lifeguard/First Aid certification
 - ☆ Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation/ Automated External Defibrillator (CPR/AED) certification
 - ☆ As a condition of employment as a swim instructor, must obtain Water Safety Instructor (WSI) certification prior to instructing swim lessons

Special Note: All certifications will be provided at no expenses to staff prior to the opening of the pool. Swimsuit uniforms, hooded sweatshirts and other gear also provided at no cost to staff.

Certification Process:

- Candidate must pass a lifeguard/swimming competency pre-test at the Bozeman Aquatics Center May 2-5 or May 6.
- Upon passing pre-test candidate must complete online course work for Lifeguard and/or WSI (8 hours of computer work per certification)
- In-pool certificate process: WSI, May 22-26 and Lifeguard, May 28 & 29
- Certifications are good for 2 years.
