Roll Call

Design Review:

- Discussion on 118 N. Main "The Stockman" Façade and Windows.
  - Questions for Commission from applicant.
    - 1. What windows would be preferred? The Commission stated that the original window size and style is the preference.
    - 2. Should the 1<sup>st</sup> floor façade and windows be returned to the original. The Commission stated that restoring the original storefront windows would be preferred.
    - 3. Does the building need to match "Wheatgrass" next door? The Commission stated that there is no need to match exactly.
- Decision on 130 N. 2<sup>nd</sup> "Dangling DooDads" Signs.
  - $\circ$   $\,$  Discussion and questions between applicant and commission.
  - Discussion on sign code, application more wall signs than allowed by zoning.
  - Discussion on the updates to the sign code and that the applicant can apply for the  $3^{rd}$  sign after the update.
  - Motion to approve two wall signs, excluding the banner sign shown on the application by Commissioner Nemetz, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Ebinger.
  - Motion passes unanimously (3:0).
- Decision on 106 S. Main "Wolf's Mercantile" Sign and Building.
  - Applicant presentation, noting that this item was also discussed at the previous meeting.
  - Commission grateful that the applicant has made the changes discussed previously, believes the new proposal is more consistent with the District.
  - $\circ$  Motion to approve by Commissioner Ebinger,  $2^{nd}$  by Commissioner Luther.
  - Motion passes unanimously (3:0).

New Business:

- Discussion on Sign Regulations and Guidelines for the Historic District.

- Request from the Commission to create definitions of halo lit, backlit, and neon signs.
- Discussion and request to update the definition of sandwich board signs to ensure that signs like sandwich board signs but utilizing a different form can remain.
- Request to add a reference to Chapter 31 of the City Ordinances into the language to ensure applicants are aware that historic design review is required within the Historic District.
- Discussion on ensuring numbering is accurate.
