(2) Cactus Blossom Collective, 111 W. Callender Street. No representative was in attendance however, after discussion, the commission decided the application was sufficiently presented and a motion was made and passed unanimously to accept the proposal.

(3) Fainting Goat Pub, 122 N. Main Street. No representative was in attendance. After discussion the commission decided more information was needed to approve the sign proposed on the Main Street entrance but the replacement of the Glens sign on Park Street using the existing pole mounting was acceptable. A motion was made and passed unanimously to approve the sign on Park Street and to advise the applicant of the need for additional data regarding the mounting, lighting and placement of the Main Street sign. The commission also needed more information regarding the vinyl window sign on Main Street.
