 - a. Sarah Stands motions to approve with no edits, Tim Stevens seconds

 - a. Recommendation on Sacajawea Park improvements Connor/Dan
 - i. Dan has a project in mind for Sacajawea's sundial area
 - ii. There is about \$20k available for parks improvements and some of that money he is looking to use to put in a new piece of play equipment in the sundial area of Sacajawea Park
 - iii. Three options for that area do nothing, do something to improve it, take it all out and turn it into a greenspace
 - 1. It was confirmed that it cannot become a pool again
 - iv. Dan spoke with Darryl at Expedition Church about helping with the improvements with a group in January or so and they'd help with painting and other small projects around the pool and could help with this area too
 - v. One thought Dan had was to put dinosaur bones into a sand pit that kids could dig up and rebury and have fun with and a climbing structure in the middle
 - 1. That said, he's open to our suggestions for the area
 - vi. PTC members will look at options for the sundial area as well as grants to help fund some structures or equipment purchases for the sundial
 - 1. Jeanne, Alison, and Sarah to explore grants
 - 2. Tim & Sarah will take lead of climbing options
 - a. Tim will email TPL about the Story Mill boulder to see who did it and possibly get cost estimates
