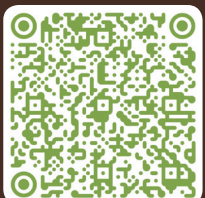

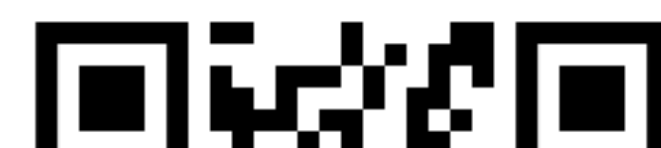

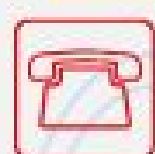

PAX Tools draws on decades of science to create strategies that support parents, youth workers, and other caring adults to create a nurturing environment that ultimately helps kids thrive!

## **Do the Tools work?**

According to over 40 years of research at places like John's Hopkins University and Wright State University, for every 100 first graders that get the kernels in school through the PAX Good Behavior Game, we'd see some great results when they reach age 21:

- 7 more kids will not be smokers
- 4 more kids will not be alcohol dependent
- 12 more kids will not be drug dependent
- 1 more kid will not commit violent crime
- 11 more kids will not need mental health services
- 7 more girls will not feel suicidal
- 9 more girls will graduate from high school
- 7 more boys will attend college
